28/26 Welcome – Cllr Scott welcomed all present to the meeting.

Apologies for absence were received and accepted from Cllr D Broadberry and Cllr M. Head.

29/26 Notes of the previous meeting – the draft minutes of the Council meeting held on the 6th May 2026 approved as a true record and signed by the Chair.

30/26 Matters arising from previous meeting : Michael Scott Memorial Bench – expected March 2027; Winchelsea Graves – decision on rent increase to be made by Lord Winchelsea later in the year; Salt container – Clerk to arrange with LCC for autumn 2026; New banking arrangements – ongoing; hedge cutting at Evedon Church – in hand; Parish Council elections – no action currently required. Council business will continue as normal throughout 2026 and into early 2027. NKDC is expected to issue nomination papers and the election timetable in March/April 2027. The new unitary authority will take effect in April 2028.

31/26 Matters arising: Proposal – Management of Cremated Remains Interments**New Cremated Remains Area**

Resolved to approve, in principle, the creation of a new dedicated cremated remains section within the cemetery, subject to the preparation of a layout and implementation plan.

Management of Cremated Remains Interments

Resolved to authorise the Clerk, in consultation with Cllr Marshall where necessary, to manage cremated remains interments on behalf of the Council, including liaising with families, allocating plots, collecting fees, maintaining cemetery records, issuing Grants of Exclusive Right of Burial, and processing memorial applications in accordance with an approved procedure.

Cremated Remains Policy

Resolved that the Clerk prepare a Cremated Remains Interment Policy for Council approval and publication on the Parish Council website.

37/26 Any Other Business

- i. Main Street and Thorpe Road Hedges – It was noted that the hedges at No. 27 Main Street and on the corner of Main Street/Thorpe Road were overgrown. The hedge on corner has now been cut. The owner of the remaining hedge will be approached and asked if it can be trimmed.
- ii. Play Area Warning Signage – A member of the public noted the absence of a "Slow" road marking/sign and a "Children Playing" warning sign near the playground at the end of the village. Cllr Lister-Tomlinson will investigate further.
- iii. Beacon Fen DCO – The decision is expected in approximately three weeks' time and will be made by the new Secretary of State. Cllr Lister-Tomlinson agreed to circulate the Planning Inspectorate's recommendation/report to members as soon as possible.
- iv. Playground Hedges – It was noted that the playground hedges require more regular trimming to prevent them becoming difficult to maintain. Cllr Scott will discuss a way forward with James Sardeson.
