

## Parish Precept 2019/20 Initial Discussion.

Councillor Scott suggest the precept remain the same as last year - everyone was in agreement; a budget document would be prepared and circulated and necessary forms submitted to NKDC.

It was unanimously agreed to make a donation of £2,500 to The Reading Room Committee - of which £901 is from Rothwell's Charity; funds being held in the Parish Council's bank account - towards the cost of the new floor, estimated to amount to £16,000 before VAT. Councillor Priestley declared an interest.


## Any Other Business.

- ii) District Councillor Head spoke about the on line consultation re the HUB asking that we encourage villagers to participate as it would be good to support local artists.
- iii) District Councillor Head spoke about the regeneration of the River Slea. A discussion followed. Members encouraged to write to the District Council to support the regeneration as an asset.
- iv) The clerk put forward a request from the Rotary Club of Sleaford Kesteven to erect a Peace Pole on the village Green. Suggested that they give a presentation as more information required recognizing the restrictions that apply to the common ground of village greens.
