

## **Oak Tree celebrating the Platinum Jubilee of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II**

In his introduction Michael Scott thanked Haverholme Estate for providing the Oak Tree and referred to the close association between the Estate and the village over many year; the Estate provided all the Oak for the reroofing of the church in the village in 1895 and two oak trees were provided in 2000 to construct the Lytch Gate at the entrance to the church.

In introducing Councillor Mick Priestley, Michael Scott stated that it was appropriate that Mick should perform the planting ceremony since he was 8 years of age when the late Queen was crowned and he had lived in the village all his life - as had his family for generations before.
