A separate application form is available for sensitive interests. If the Monitoring Officer agrees then the interest will be excluded from versions of the register that are available for public inspection or publication.

  - (b) in the case of a councillor, before or at the first meeting of the parish or community council after his election; or
  - (c) in either case if the council at that meeting so permit, before or at a later meeting fixed by the council.
- He shall make the declaration in the presence of a member of the council or of the proper officer of the council and deliver to the council a declaration of acceptance of office in a form prescribed by an order made by the Secretary of State, and if he fails to do so his office shall thereupon become vacant.
